### **Considerations**

The submission is agreed by Health and Environment Justice Support (HEJSupport), Swedish Society for Nature Conservation (SSNC), European Environmental Bureau (EEB), Friends of the Earth Germany, Pesticide Action Network (PAN), CIEL, IPEN.

For SAICM 2.0 become efficient and effective, it is important to move issues of concern which have not been addressed adequately as well as new issues of concern as they emerge into agreements with increased obligations. We should set time bound goals and targets for issues of concern, and define clear criteria for how to move the issues ahead if they have not progressed as expected. Governments and other stakeholders should consider defining criteria for nominating such issues and progress them to the next level with increased obligations.
