- A passport is required for traveling to Romania. Travelers are urged to seek information on visa requirements for their nationality prior to travel. Please check and confirm requirements on the Ministry of Foreign Affairs website: <http://evisa.mae.ro/home>
- Conditions that should be met in order to be allowed entry to Romania can be consulted at: <http://www.mae.ro/en/node/30320>
- To apply for an appropriate entry visa to Romania, participants are required to contact their respective Romanian Embassy/Consulate-General for accurate information regarding visa application procedures and required documents.
- Participants who apply for a visa outside their country of residence or who reside in a country where there is no Romanian Embassy/Consulate/Consulate General should check for the location(s) where it is possible to apply for a Romanian visa. Please note that certain nationalities, for security reasons, are not allowed to apply for a visa except at the Romanian Embassy/Consulate-General which has jurisdiction over the concerned territory. Please also consult <http://evisa.mae.ro/NeedVisa> to see specific requirements. Please note that applicants must possess a valid passport of at least six months and must be in possession of a valid return ticket with date of departure within 15 days of the date of entry.
