Target name and Strategic Objective

Target C1: As an ongoing process, stakeholders nominate and the international conference adopts issues of concern and supporting workplans with specific responsibilities of relevant stakeholders, specific measurable targets, timelines, and reporting schemes.

Strategic Objective C: Issues of concern [that warrant [global] [and] [joint] action] are identified, prioritized and addressed.

Concept

Strategic Objective C is a process-oriented objective relating to the Issues of Concern with intentions to ensure that issues are nominated, adopted and implemented in order to make progress in fields in need of common attention and action. Target C1 addresses the inception phase with the aim that new Issues of Concern projects are continuously nominated and adopted. The target includes a reference to the workplans of the nominated issues with responsibilities, targets, timelines and reporting schemes in order to ensure an ambitious approach when addressing each issue.
