### **Note by the secretariat**

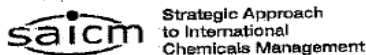

**Correspondence between the co-chairs of the Quick Start Programme Executive Board and the Executive Director of the United Nations Environment Programme on the proposal to recognize contributors to the Quick Start Programme and other activities to support the implementation of the Strategic Approach to International Chemicals Management**

Dear Mr Steiner,

The Quick Start Programme (QSP) of the Strategic Approach to International Chemicals Management (SAICM) has completed its second year of implementation and has proven to be a valuable funding mechanism to support chemical safety activities in developing countries and countries with economies in transition.

In 2007, the QSP Executive Board adopted the QSP business plan, which outlines a strategy to ensure the sustainable provision of resources. The strategy included the establishment of a framework for official recognition and awards to be considered for possible recommendation to the second session of the International Conference on Chemicals Management to be held in Geneva from 11 to 15 May 2009.

Following consideration of the proposal contained in the business plan, the Executive Board suggests that, in your capacity of convenor of the Conference, you consider inviting the Conference to formally recognize all QSP contributors and recommends special acknowledgement to multi-year contributors and developing country contributors. It was also proposed that you may wish to extend this recognition to other SAICM contributors, outside the framework of the QSP. A draft list of potential awardees is attached.

You may wish to consider inviting the President of the second session of the Conference to join you or your representative in presenting the awards to QSP and other contributors during the main reception of the Conference on the evening of Monday 11 May 2009.

We look forward to having your views on this proposal for awards.
